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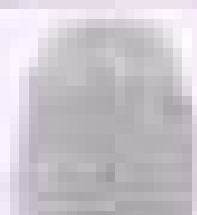
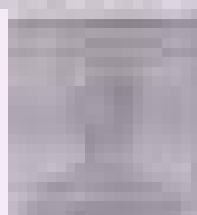
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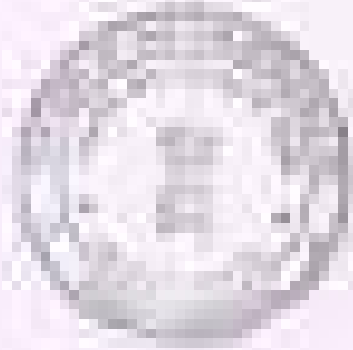
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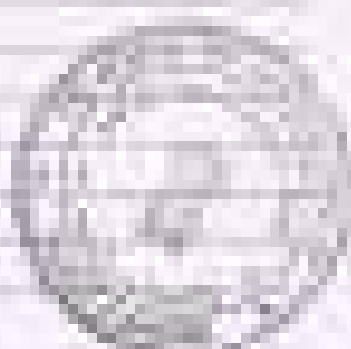
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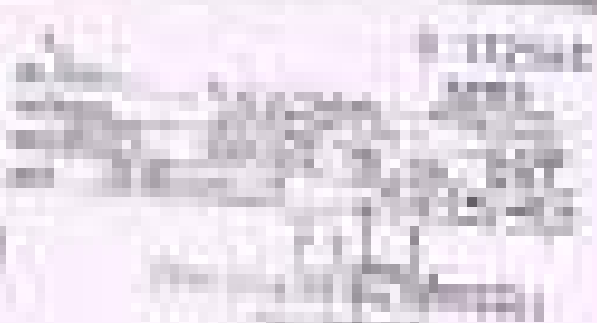
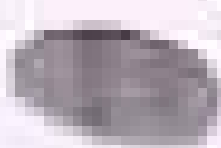
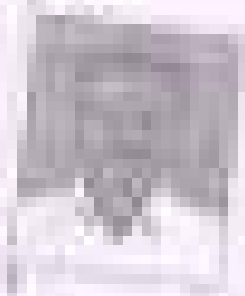
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Abstract: This paper examines the effects of the 1997-1998 Asian financial crisis on the export performance of the manufacturing sector in the Philippines. The paper finds that the crisis had a significant negative impact on the export performance of the manufacturing sector.
