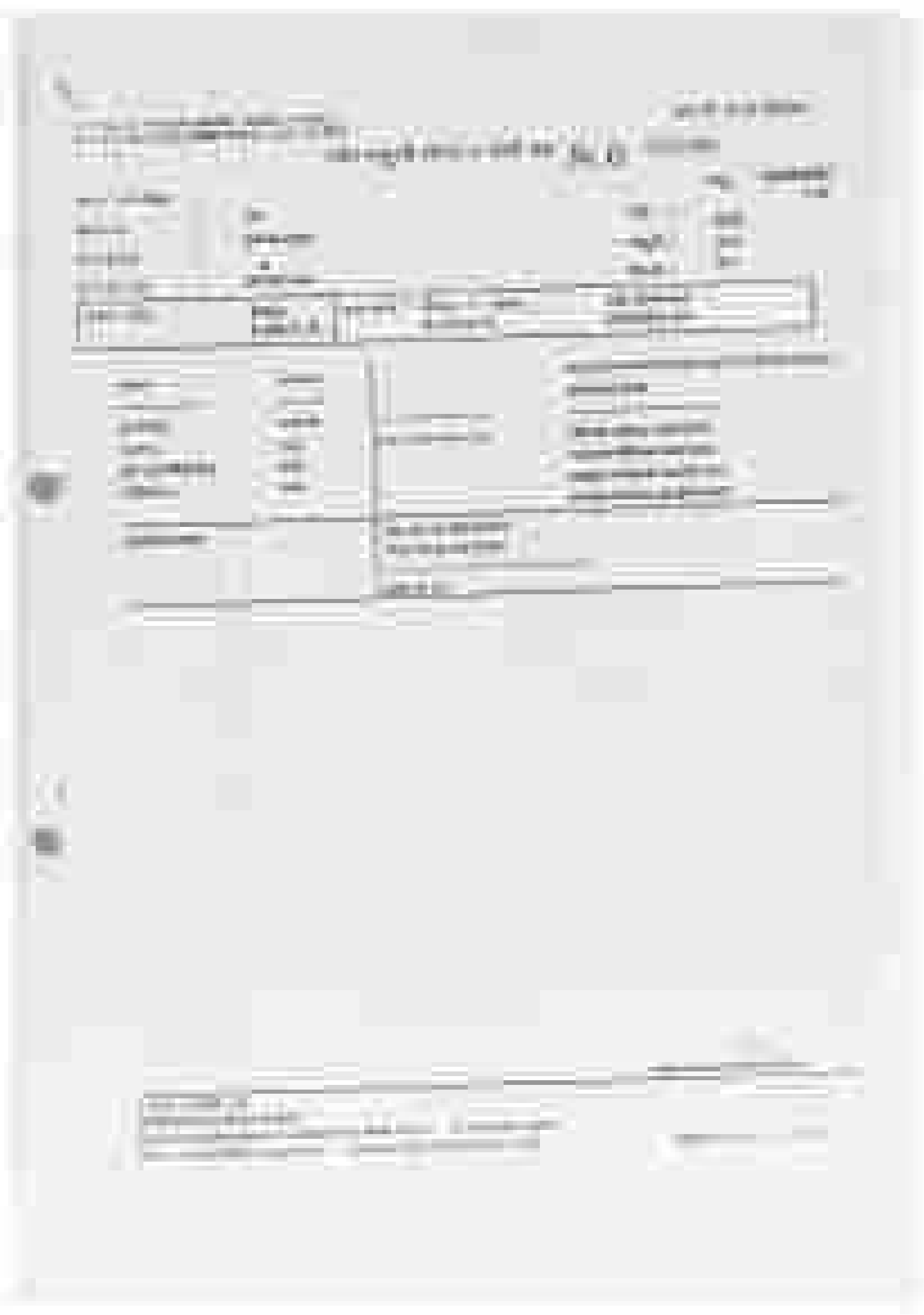


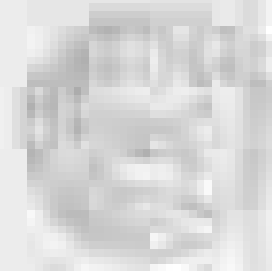
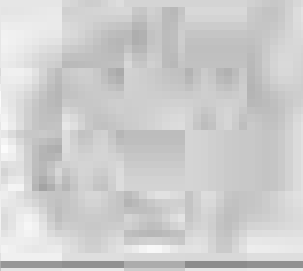


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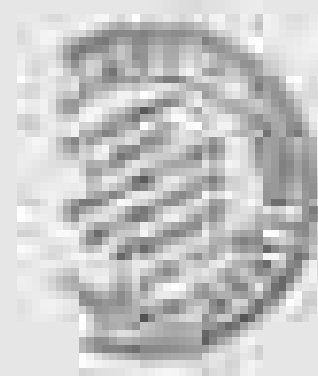


Figure 1. A circular inset image showing a close-up of a textured surface, possibly a seed or a small object, with a grid-like pattern.

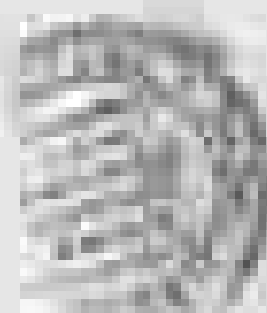

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Figure 1. The effect of the concentration of the *Agrobacterium* suspension on the transformation efficiency of *Agrobacterium* strains.

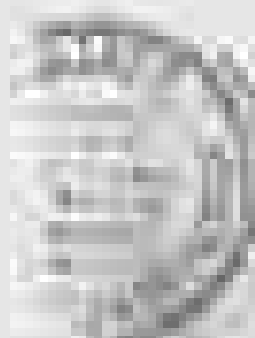
