The audit will be conducted by a certified public accountant (CPA) who is a member of the Massachusetts Institute of Certified Public Accountants.

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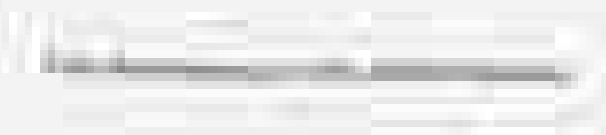
