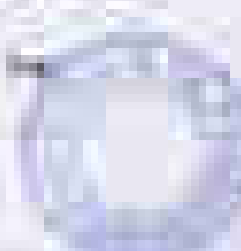

The most likely cause of these symptoms is a pulmonary embolism (PE), which is a blockage in the pulmonary artery. The other options are less likely: aortic dissection (B) typically presents with severe chest pain; myocardial infarction (C) typically presents with chest pain and ECG changes; and pneumonia (D) typically presents with cough, sputum, and fever.

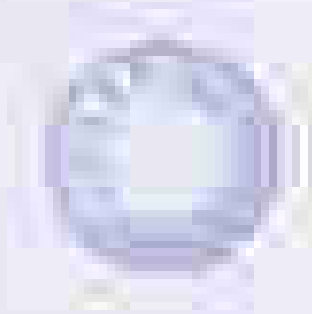

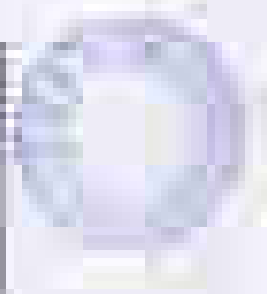
